Auction Sign Installations



**Preferred Method:**  
2 Dug in wooden posts (posts not provided by auction.com). Auction signage then attached to wood posts via staples/screws.



### Method 2:

Zip ties used around surrounding gates/fences to provide for maximum street traffic exposure

**\*Be sure you are applying to correct unit, bldg, or whichever is applicable**



### Method 3:

**Retail Store Front with no place for posts and/or no fence visible, sign applied onto center of exposed window (tape or suction cups).**

**--Vacant -- Use gorilla duct tape on back, and seal with clear tape around all 4 side. Use best judgment to cause least amount of structural damage.**

**--Occupied -- Call into Auction.com contact and verify that signs are permitted.**

**\*If yes, make contact with tenants and advise them of your presence.**

**\*If no, verify visit with photo and leave. You will still be paid trip fee.**
